Measurements are from lot line to lot line

SMALL GARDEN

Street Frontage - 20 ft. frontage - / 6.096 meters

MEDIUM GARDEN

Street Frontage -21 ft. to 50ft. frontage / 15.5 meters

LARGE GARDEN

Street Frontage - 51 ft. / 15.5meters or larger

NEW GARDEN

The garden must be less than 3 yrs old .

GARDEN ART/STRUCTURES

Use of art or hardscaping in the garden that enhances the overall harmony and design.

SENIOR GARDEN

The garden is planted and maintained by gardeners over 65 years of age.

NON-RESIDENTIAL GARDEN

COMMERICAL GARDEN

Office buildings, golf courses, hotels, churches, cemeteries retail, etc.

COMMUNITY GARDEN

The garden is planted and maintained by a community group. Includes residential care facilities, co-operative gardens, etc.

EDUCATION INSTITUTION GARDEN

The gardens are planted and maintained by students and volunteers.
